Description In order to enforce the restrictions, implementations should look up themselves in the node registry to see whether or not they allow the method to be called by the given subject. A NotAuthorized exception should be thrown if they are not allowed to call the method. If a service lacks any restrictions, it is considered open to all users (subject, of course, to the permission rules that are in force for any data or metadata that the method interacts with).
