There is a general requirement for expressing relationships between tickets which can be done using trac links (e.g. <a href="#">#184</a> ) but there is no way to generate a report of relationships or critical path from such links.			
There is a "plugin": <a href="http://trac-hacks.org/wiki/MasterTicketsPlugin">http://trac-hacks.org/wiki/MasterTicketsPlugin</a> for this, but this also requires installation of graphviz.			
This task is to perform evaluation of the plugin on a separate system to see if it works as expected before recommending installation on the primary trac site.
