Description

The ONEMercury search results page renders a 'bookmark' button depending on the browser agent detected. The button creates a browser bookmark to the current (search) page.

Google Chrome does not allow javascript to create bookmarks - this button should not appear in Google Chrome. The browser sniffing/detection logic must not be handling chrome properly.

Low risk fix - targeting for 1.0.3 initially due to low risk.
