Description

For security reasons, as a log file consolidation, the current design is that the splunk server will not use DataONE accounts for login. That way, compromise of a DataONE credential cannot directly result in compromise of the Splunk server. The objective of this work is to finalize the details, and document those details, for who has login accounts, make sure that those people have appropriate ssh keys for login, with appropriate restrictions on root/sudo access.
