 - o Suggest adding JSR 303 annotations to fields (@Null, @NotNull, @Email, @Size etc)
 - o Suggest adding constructors / static factories to assist in correct usage
 - o Consider making them all interfaces and provide immutable implementations
 - o probably the overhead of this is too large, and means implementators have to register factories in e.g. Jixb
 - o this one is debatable, as these are probably used only for unmarshalling from XML which is known to be valid
 - o although on the response, it allows people to easily produce bad XML
 - o hmmmmm, tricky one will come back to this
