Description

Metacat MN.create and CN.create share the code to check if the identifier exists. But it only checks two places - identifier table and systemmetadata table. It is a local check and this check may be correct for CN. But in the MN.create documentation: The pid must not exist in the DataONE system.

So MN.create should call the CN.reservelidentifier(id) to check if the id exists in the system wide.
