We need a field in the index that will reliably give the PID for any object, and all objects will still have a PID in the new system. If we need a combined field with PID and SID, I think we should create it as a new field. Many calling apps may now assume the identifier field contains the PID, and so changing its semantics could break some client apps. Adding a new field would not.
