Description <p>The constructor for SolrConnection accepts a "persistent" property that indicates if the instance should attempt to keep client connections open rather than closing after each request.</p> <p>Setting this to False causes the connection attempt to immediately fail with error "ResponseNotReady".</p> <p>Overall, the solr connection should probably be refactored to use the python "requests" package, which offers a far more stable HTTP client.</p>
