<p>Mutable Member Nodes that only retain the latest version of their entities rarely do the bookkeeping work on orphaned versions they no longer host. This includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. setting the obsoletedBy field of the the orphaned object2. transferring authority to another node (CN or MN)3. invalidating the replica in the Replica section <p>This leads to problems in search, resolve, and updating system metadata.</p> <p>I propose we utilize the new CN-carve-out Node Properties to enable the CN to perform these actions on the mutable member node's behalf. This can either be done with a blanket property 'isMutable', or something more specific, because some member nodes might orphan the object, but keep the system metadata. 'autoObsolete', 'autoDeorphan', 'autoReplicaAudit', or such...</p>
